Anti-Ragging Committee


In accordance with the AICTE Notification No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01.07.2009, MIT School of Distance Education has constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure a ragging-free campus. The Member Secretary is responsible for coordinating all activities and maintaining records related to anti-ragging measures.

Key Points:

- Prohibition of Ragging: Ragging, whether within or outside the educational institution, is strictly prohibited.
- Punishment for Ragging: Any student who directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging shall be punished with imprisonment for a term of up to 2 years and/or a fine that may extend to ₹10,000.
- Consequences of Conviction: A student convicted of ragging shall be dismissed from the institution and will be barred from admission to any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of dismissal.
- Legal Mandate: The prohibition of ragging is in line with the Supreme Court of India's decision in Writ Petition (C) No. 656/1998.

The committee ensures strict enforcement of anti-ragging policies, promotes awareness among students, and maintains a safe and respectful campus environment.
